**DAY 5 WARNEMÜNDE (BERLIN), GERMANY (B/L/D)** Warnemünde, the gateway to Germany's capital, Berlin, offers a wonderful combination of history, architecture and culture. Unter den Linden leads to the heart of old Berlin, with its Prussian palaces and monuments. Humboldt-Universität nurtured some of Germany's greatest thinkers, including Einstein, the Brothers Grimm, and Karl Marx. See the medieval fortress, Zitadelle Spandau, with the Julisturm (Julius Tower), or enjoy the cafés and clubs of Kreuzberg. We'll depart Warnemünde this evening.

**DAY 6 CRUISE THE BALTIC SEA** (B/L/D) Enjoy the shipboard activities during a lovely day of cruising. Relax or take one of the many lifestyle classes, ranging from cooking and gardening to health and wellness or computer technology...something for everyone!

**DAY 7 TALLINN, ESTONIA** (B/L/D) You'll find a cultural mix and unique ambiance in maritime Tallinn, from the Old Town's cobblestone streets to the city's heritage of medieval buildings. Visit the grand City Hall; the Estonian Orthodox Church; Toompea Castle, the seat of the Parliament; and Oleviste Church. See former guild houses, including the Great Guild Hall; impressive Raekoja Plats, Town Hall Square; Hirve Park; the Gothic church, Toomkirik; and, "Tall Herman" and "Fat Margaret", two towers standing among the remnants of the original defense walls. We'll stay overnight in St. Petersburg.

**DAY 9 ST. PETERSBURG, RUSSIA** (B/L/D) Enjoy another day in this fascinating city. Stroll down the main avenue, Nevsky Prospekt, lined with impressive buildings; including, Arts Square and the Russian Museum; Kazan Cathedral; and the huge department store, Gostiny Dvor. Visit the Summer Palace, the famous Amber Room in Catherine's Palace, and the Mariinsky Theatre; or enjoy a performance at the opera or ballet. We'll depart St. Petersburg early evening.

**DAY 10 HELSINKI, FINLAND** (B/L/D) Referred to as the "Pearl of the Baltic," this city is known for its impressive architecture, wide boulevards, and beautiful harbor. Visit the colorful Market Square and the Temppeliaukio Kirkko (Rock Church), built inside a massive chunk of natural granite; Grand Senate Square, dominated by the exquisite Tuomio Church and the onion-shaped cupolas of the Russian Orthodox Uspensky Cathedral; Suomenlinna Fortress, a major monument of military architecture; and, the national park on the island of Seurassari, where you'll find the largest collection of historic buildings, each moved here from somewhere else. Finland's musical heritage comes alive in Finlandia Hall, designed by renowned architect Alvar Aalto. We'll depart Helsinki late afternoon.

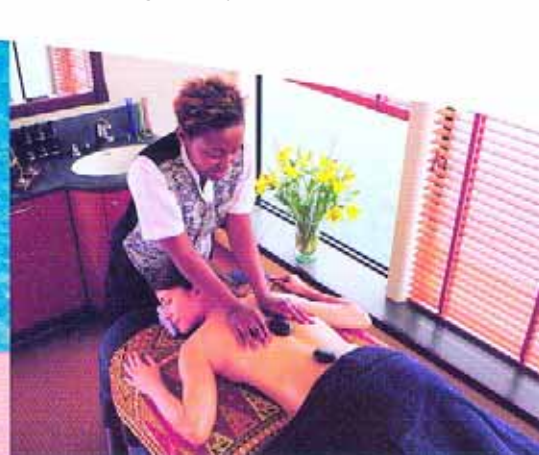
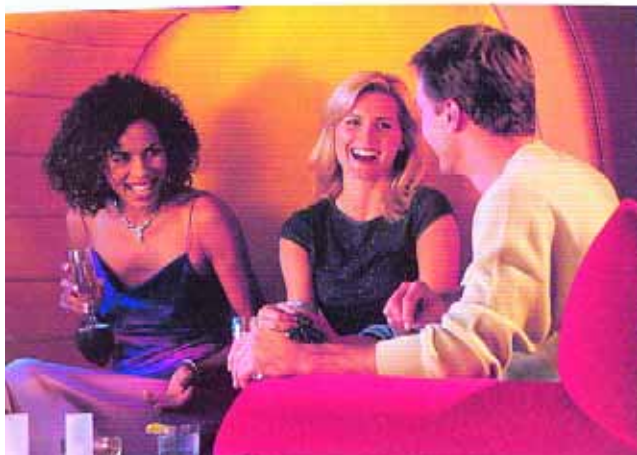
